Community Partner Promotion Package: Resources for Sharing the CVDD Calculator

Thank you for considering using and sharing the COVID-19 Vaccination Due Date Calculator (CVDD Calc) with your patients, networks, and communities.

The CVDD Calc is a free, online tool that helps people figure out when they may be due for a COVID-19 shot, making it easier to stay up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccination.

The CVDD Calc can be used by anyone, such as healthcare workers, family members, friends, or the general public. The calculator provides a COVID-19 vaccination due date for children, adolescents, and adults at any stage of their vaccination journey, including for those who are moderately to severely immunocompromised.

To receive a COVID-19 vaccination due date, the information needed for calculation includes:

- birthdate,
- type and number of COVID-19 shots received (if any),
- whether immunocompromised (definition provided within the calculator), and
- the date of most recent COVID-19 shot (if any).

As a community health partner, you are a trusted source of COVID-19 information across your networks. We appreciate the essential role you play in keeping our West Virginia communities safe and informed.

Hearing about the challenges that many people have regarding the varied individual timelines for staying up-to-date on COVID-19 vaccination, our hope is that the WV COVID-19 Vaccination Due Date Calculator helps alleviate some of that reasonable confusion.

With that in mind, the goal is to make it as simple as possible for you to share clear, consistent, scientifically sound COVID-19 vaccination information and recommendations.

The following pages and links include tips and resources for sharing.



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There are two main ways you can share this calculator. To overview:

- (1) **EMBED.** Embed it on your website's homepage or other page so that your visitors can use the calculator directly within a page of your website; and/or
- (2) **LINK/SHARE.** Share the link to vaccinate.wv.gov using your website, electronic materials, printed materials, and/or social media (links to resources, templates, and QR Code provided below).

Instructions for each method, along with related templates and resources, are next.

Calculator Sharing Details/Instructions:

1. **EMBED.** Embed the calculator directly on your organization's website. This allows you to retain your site visitors and enables them to complete the calculation without navigating to another page. [Here's a resource](#) from HubSpot for how to add HTML embed codes to your website (scroll down to "How to Embed an External Web Page"). To add the calculator onto an existing [asp.net](#) page, use the following:

Tips: In the event of any issues with scroll bars, or problems when the site is in mobile mode, the following should be included in the <head ...></head> portion of the page. It should follow the <title/> tag. (Note: If this is something you don't have access to update, you should be able to work with your site's provider to get it included.)

2. **LINK/SHARE.** Share the link to vaccinate.wv.gov by hyperlinking to it on your organization's website; sharing the provided QR code on printed materials in your office; sending messages via your electronic channels such as patient portals, email, or text messages; and/or sharing the provided graphics/captions via your social media channels. *See resources below.*
